Krolak's Favorite Phoenix

PINNACLE PEAK PARK TRAIL

Head out on this 4.0-mile out-and-back trail near Scottsdale, Arizona. Generally considered a moderately challenging route, it takes an average of 2 h 14 min to complete. This is a very popular area for birding, hiking, and rock climbing, so you'll likely encounter other people while exploring. The trail is open year-round and is beautiful to visit anytime. You'll need to leave pups at home — dogs aren't allowed on this trail.

GATEWAY TRAILHEAD

Check out this 11.6-mile out-and-back trail near Scottsdale, Arizona. Generally considered a challenging route, it takes an average of 5 h 46 min to complete. This is a popular trail for birding and hiking, but you can still enjoy some solitude during quieter times of day. The best times to visit this trail are September through May. Dogs are welcome, but must be on a leash.

PAPAGO PARK BUTTE LOOP

Try this 2.2-mile loop trail near Tempe, Arizona. Generally considered an easy route, it takes an average of 45 min to complete. This is a very popular area for hiking, mountain biking, and trail running, so you'll likely encounter other people while exploring. The trail is open year-round and is beautiful to visit anytime. Dogs are welcome, but must be on a leash.

SPUR CROSS DRAGONFLY LOOP

Check out this 3.9-mile loop trail near Cave Creek, Arizona. Generally considered a moderately challenging route, it takes an average of 1 h 31 min to complete. This is a popular trail for hiking and walking, but you can still enjoy some solitude during quieter times of day. The best times to visit this trail are October through May. Dogs are welcome, but must be on a leash. **Krolak's** Favorite Northern Arizona

Crystal Point Loop Trail

A 5 mile moderately trafficked out and back trail located near Munds Park, Arizona that features a lake and is good for all skill levels. The trail is primarily used for hiking, walking, nature trips, and bird watching. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash.

Lockett Meadow Inner Basin Loop

A 3.4 mile heavily trafficked loop trail located near Flagstaff, Arizona that features beautiful wild flowers and is rated as moderate. The trail is primarily used for hiking and is best used from May until October. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash.

Schnebly Hill Road OHV Route

A 11.8 mile heavily trafficked point-to-point trail located near Sedona, Arizona that features beautiful wild flowers and is rated as moderate. The trail is primarily used for hiking and ohv/off road driving and is accessible year-round.

STEP 3 - REDEEM

When visiting a participating wineries, simply present your phone to the attendant or staff member to redeem available discounts. For check-ins, you must be within .25 miles of winery.

CANYON LAKE

Approximately 15 miles (24 km) up the Apache Trail from Apache Junction, Arizona and 51 miles (82 km) east of Phoenix



BARTLETT- NOEL (CAMPING) This site is 23 miles east of Carefree. Take Cave Creek Road 7 miles. Turn right on Bartlett Dam Road and continue for 12 ½ miles. Then turn

left on FR 459. Continue for 12 ½ miles. Then turn left on FR 459. Continue on FR 459 (a paved, low-speed road) for 3 miles and an additional ½-mile on an unpaved road to the site



BLUE WATER RESERVOIR

55 miles south of Flagstaff to Clints Well on Forest Highway 3 (Lake Mary Road). Turn northeast (left) about 4 miles on AZ 87 to FR 751 then southeast about 6 more miles to the reservoir.


